### **Mental Health Advisory Committee Seeks Members**

The Department is currently seeking to fill several openings on the Medicaid Mental Health Advisory Committee. Our goal is to widen stakeholder representation to better reflect the diversity of our program participants.

The purpose of the Committee is to exchange information and identify, evaluate and communicate issues related to the Colorado Medicaid Community Mental Health Services Program. Meetings are held on the fourth Thursday of each month from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. at the Department, 1570 Grant Street, Denver, CO. Committee meetings are open to the public; interested persons are encouraged to attend a meeting prior to applying for membership.

Committee appointees represent the following stakeholders:

- Behavioral Health Organizations (BHOs)
- Mental Health Program service providers
- Colorado Community Health Network and homeless initiatives
- Developmental disabilities community
- Colorado Psychiatric Society
- Adults and youth who receive services through the Mental Health Program
- Parents of children/youth/adults who receive services through the Mental Health Program

The application period will be open until maximum membership of 25 members is reached. Members are expected to attend at least 2/3 of all scheduled meetings during each year. Term limits are two years, with a limit of three consecutive terms. Members will be notified of acceptance by U.S. mail or e-mail.
